

Karl is baking a loaf of bread and needs 0.8 kg of flour.

He has 72 grams of flour.

How much more flour does Karl need? Give your answer in grams.

0.8kg = 800 g 800 - 7 Z



Work out the difference between the sum of 16 and 21 and the product of 16 and 21

16+21=37 (SUM) 16 x21 = 336 (product)

336 - 37 = 299
