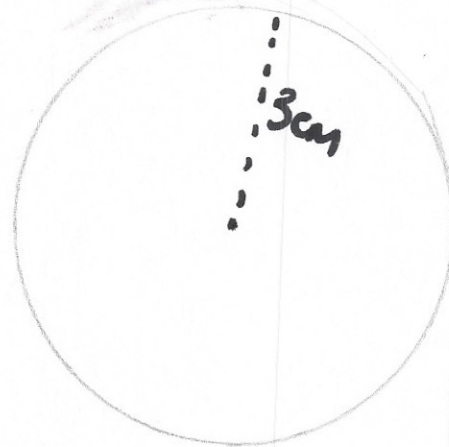

Draw a circle with a radius of 3cm.



What size is the diameter of the circle?

6cm

There are red, white and yellow counters in a bag.

For every 3 red counters, there are 2 white counters.

There are 25% more yellow counters than red counters.

If there are 40 white counters in the bag, how many yellow counters are there?

$$3:2 = 60:40$$

so 60 red

$$25\% \text{ more is } 60 + 15 = \underline{75}$$
