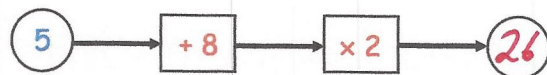

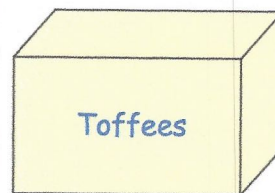
$$13 \times 2 = 26$$
