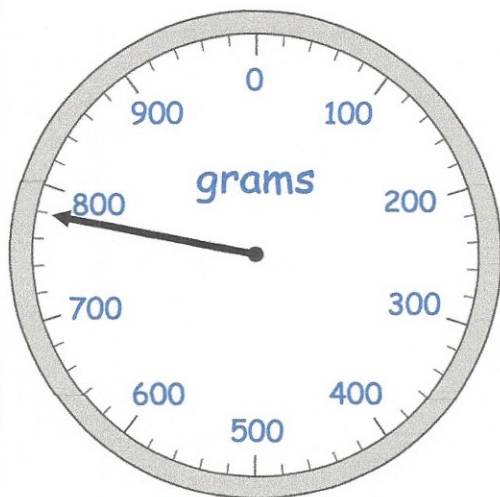

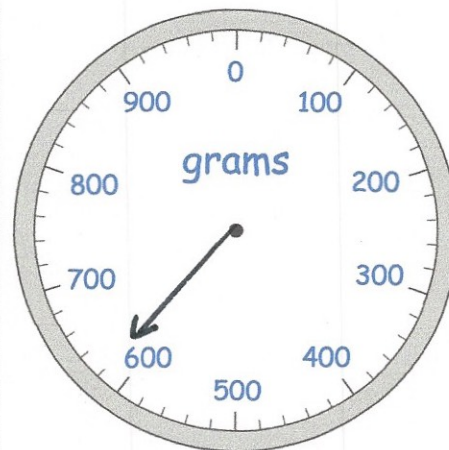

How much more does Emma's toy cost than Tom's toy?
