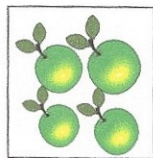
Is Martha correct?

Explain your answer

Yes, multiples of 5 end in 0 or 5



Pepper
£0.75 each



Apples
£1.60 for a tray



Strawberries
£3.50 for 1 kilogram

Ava buys two peppers, a tray of apples and half a kilogram of strawberries.

How much change does she get from £10?

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \times 0.75 = \pounds 1.50 \\ \frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 3.50 = \pounds 1.75 \\ \pounds 1.60 \\ \hline 4.85 \end{array}$$

$$10 - 4.85 = \pounds 5.15$$
