Karl is baking a loaf of bread and needs 0.9 kg of flour.

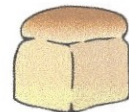
He has 85 grams of flour.

$$0.9 \text{ kg} = 900g$$

$$900 - 85 = 815g$$



Tia, Emily and Olivia share some sweets.

Tia has twice as many sweets as Olivia.  
Emily has four times as many sweets as Tia.

If Olivia has 8 sweets, how many sweets do they have altogether?

$$\text{Olivia } 8$$

$$\text{Tia } 8 \times 2 = 16$$

$$\text{Emily } 16 \times 4 = 64$$

$$\text{Total} = \underline{\underline{88}}$$
