<p>There are 16 pupils in a class. The teacher has 7 litres of water. She pours 140 millilitres of water for every pupil.</p> <p>How much water is left over? 4.76L</p>	<p><math>16 \times 140 = 2240 \text{ ml}</math></p> <p><math>= 2.24 \text{ litres}</math></p> <p><math>7 - 2.24 = 4.76</math></p>
