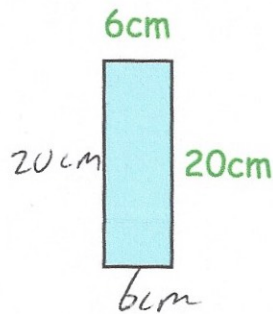

$$56 - 12 = £44 \text{ (Annie)}$$

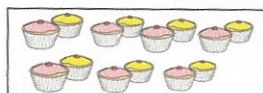
