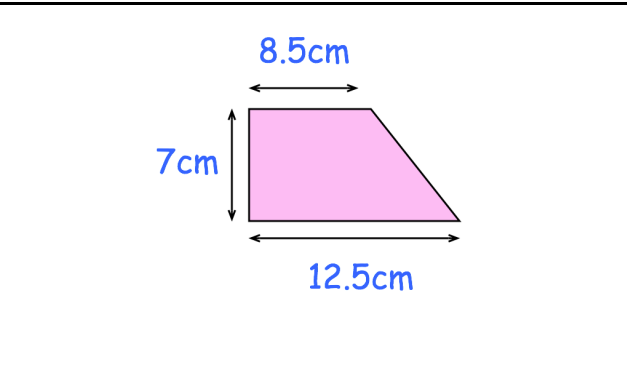
Find the value of w in this equation
