A bookshelf in a classroom is 112cm long.

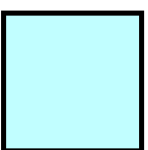
A teacher has 30 maths books, each 4cm wide.

Work out the cost of 1 drink.



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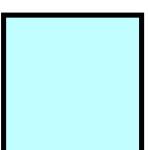
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
