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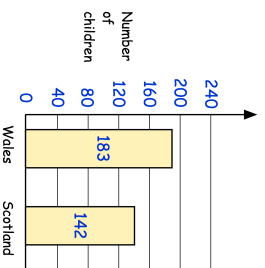

$$0.13 \quad \frac{3}{20} \quad 12\% \quad \frac{1}{10} \quad 0.09$$



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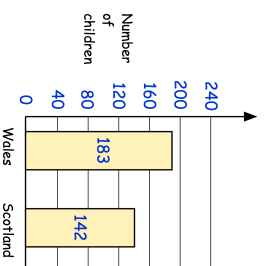
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
