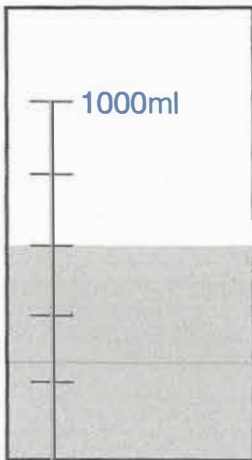

This jug has water in it.

Peter pours **450 millilitres** of water out of this jug.

How much water will be left in the jug?

150ml

Peter then pours **550 millilitres** of water into the jug.

How much water will now be in the jug?

$150 + 550 = 700\text{ml}$

Erin needs 22 cupcakes

There are four cupcakes in a box.

How many boxes does Erin need to buy?



$22 \div 4 = 5.5$
