This week Harry spent  $\frac{2}{3}$  of his pocket money on a ticket for a match.

He also spent  $\frac{1}{9}$  of his pocket money on a scarf at the match.

What fraction of his pocket money has Harry spent?

$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{9} = \frac{6}{9} + \frac{1}{9} = \frac{7}{9}$$

Sarah has the same number of 2p coins as 5p coins.

Sarah has £2.10 in 2p coins.

How much money does Sarah have in total?

£7.35

£2.10 in 2ps is 105 coins

$$105 \times 5p = 525p$$
