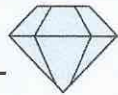

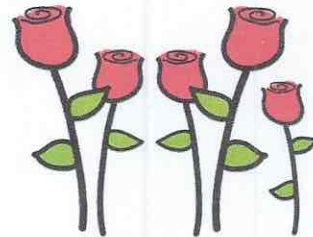
$\frac{1}{2}$ of 22 = 11

How many roses are in 11 bunches?

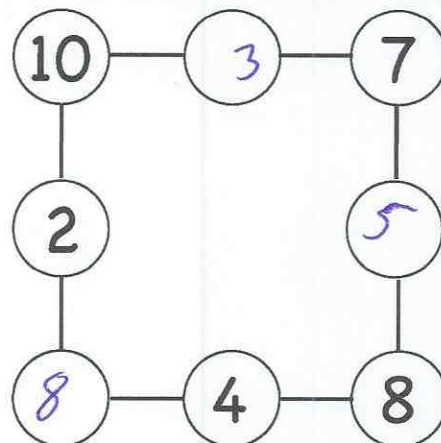
$5 \times 11 = 55$

How many matches did the team lose?

$20 \div 4 = 5$

$5 + 11 = 16$
