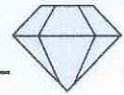

There are 12 cars in a car park.

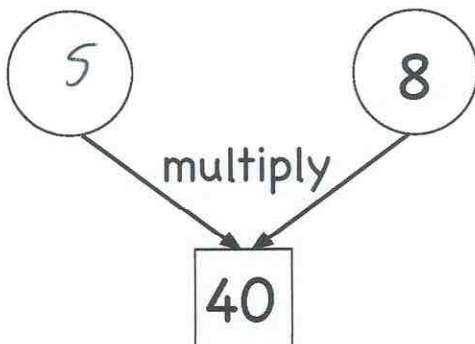
$\frac{3}{4}$  of the cars are red.
