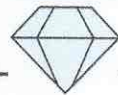

The rest of the apples are green.

How many green apples are in the bag?

$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 12 = 3$

$12 - 3 = 9$

Greg buys a toy that costs £26

He pays with six £5 notes.

How much change does Greg get?

$6 \times 5 = 30$

$30 - 26 = 4$
